FLAT BOLD sat under a snug hold tracking the pace fight from the pocket, spun into the lane and was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind a wall of rivals from upper to midstretch, inched his way forward, with the pilot still atop with a firm grip on the reins, and sat wedged between rivals from the furlong marker to the sixteenth pole, eventually gained enough space between two of the front runners to make his move and did so, bursting through with a strong kick to take charge, edged away, crossing the wire under hand encouragement. LEAVE OF ABSENCE sat well rated in the three path off the ongoing speed duel, was given his cue turning for home, bid from between rivals from the three path for command approaching the eighth pole, had no answer once the winner shook loose from his traffic predicament, but continued on willingly to garner place honors. SAM SPARKLE sat under a good hold from the outside for the opening half, was placed widest of all coming to the three-sixteenths pole, displayed a mild rally down the outside out en route for the show. W. W.'S LADY'S MAN got off a beat slowly, was lightly hand urged past a threesome to grab a forward post, sparred with ARCH TRAVELER from the outside for most of the way down the backstretch as well as around the bend, with the remainder of the group of five all within striking distance, continued the fight from between rivals during the run through the furlongs, weakened slightly in the late stages from his earlier efforts. ARCH TRAVELER got hooked up in a protracted pace dispute shortly after leaving the starting gate, went at on nearly even terms with W.W.'S LADY'S MAN to the quarter pole, with a trio of rivals just behind being well rated, came under severe pressure after entering the stretch, battled on gamely until about the sixteenth pole before backing away.
