Footnotes

I BET TONI KNOWS departed the backstretch from the three path, improved position during the run around the bend, entered the stretch and took off in earnest after the leader, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, had more success afterwards, gained ground readily on the weakening leader, took over, then staved off the late rail-skimming runner up to prove best. DYNA VISION unhurried from off the inside for nearly a half, swung four wide into the stretch, went for a short distance down the road, angled sharply to the rail, making it there by the three-sixteenths pole, closed with good energy hugging the inside thereafter to garner the place. KARMA POLICE three wide around the turn, spun from there under urging into the lane, flattened out. CAUGHT BY YOU underwent a four wide pursuit, displayed some belated energy to grab the last major check. GABRILICIOUS along the rail down the backstretch, chose the two path for the run around the turn, was already under strong encouragement turning for home, hesitated coming to the three-sixteenths pole, caught in a bit tight for a stride as the second place finisher was maneuvering over towards the rail, before advancing past a tiring rival, appeared to be making up some ground when forced to check and alter course to the rail to avoid clipping the heels of a now-tiring OFFLEE CRAFTY in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, got going once more for a short distance before taken in hand a second time, to swerve past the fallen rival in deep stretch. SHEA GOODBYE gave chase for a half, was tiring when forced to steady, affected by the incident in deep stretch. OFFLEE CRAFTY underwent a tepid chase on the pacesetter from the two path, gave way by the eighth pole, then was steadied to move around the fallen opponent just before reaching the finish line. SHES LOCA took the inside route, was done by the eighth pole, got taken in hand maneuvering by the fallen horse in the late stages. SUAVE N SASSY was guided over to the rail at the seven-sixteenths pole, failed to reach a contending position, made contact with the prostrate rival after unsuccessfully attempting to swerve by that opponent, struck the rail hard as well and lost the jockey. MOB WIFE moved up leaving the starting gate to assume the front, set the pace from near the inside on an open lead, left the eighth pole with a comfortable advantage but now appearing choppy-gaited, continued to shorten stride, losing all of the lead as the others closed in, fell heavily on the track a short distance from the finish line and unseated the rider.

There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident in deep stretch before the result was declared official.
