Footnotes

RED BULLET was rated along inside on the backstretch, angled out and advanced three wide approaching the stretch, responded when set down for the drive, reached the front nearing the eighth pole, drew clear then dug in and held off APTITUDE under a drive. APTITUDE was hustled along early, rallied inside on the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and finished fast. PERFORMING MAGIC raced close up while four wide and stayed on well to the finish. FIGHT FOR ALLY raced close up inside while under wraps and stayed on well along the rail. APPEALING DANGER quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. ACRES broke awkwardly, raced wide and was forced to steady when shut off in upper stretch. MAX'S PAL chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. FAJARDO was rated along outside, raced five wide on the turn and tired in the stretch. GANGSTA RAP contested the pace while between rivals and tired.
