FRAZIL away in good order, assumed a good forward position and was placed under a firm hold, ;patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path during the opening half, moved up when ready to challenge soon after departing the half mile pole, went by without the need of being asked for speed, was however, asked shortly afterwards when the runner up arrived on the scene in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, fought on even terms with that opponent during the ensuing furlong, shook free at that station, drew out to a lengthy advantage and had no difficulty maintaining it. ALL IN NO OUTS reserved along the outside, was asked to pick up the pace early on the far turn, kicked in with good energy to test the top one coming to the five-sixteenths pole, locked horns with that rival for an additional furlong, failed to keep pace thereafter, but easily held the place, under light urging during the last sixteenth. SHERAGUSKA coaxed tracking the front runners from the inside, got out finished. JOE CORRIGAN outrun for nearly five furlongs, was maneuvered into the three path in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, spun wide into the lane, got called upon but lacked the needed response. SHOW TRIAL lagged behind in the early going, attempted to rally four wide at the head of the stretch but wasn't up to the task. FRENCH TRANSITION three wide around the opening bend, worked his way into the two path before reaching the subsequent one, was put to a prolonged drive but came up empty. GENTLE EDWIN set the pace along the inside, and retreated once displaced.
