Footnotes

PRINCE DUBAI rode the rail within range during the early stages, slipped into the two path just prior to reaching the second turn, was asked to pick up the pace during the later stages of the run around the second turn, in preparation for the stretch drive, swung three wide into upper stretch under strong encouragement, reached the eighth pole on nearly even terms with the runner up, with IGOTURBACK lurking a dangerous threat directly to the their inside, fought it out intensely with EMPIRE EXPRESS the rest of the way and got the head down in time at the wire to prove best. EMPIRE EXPRESS was rated stalking the pacesetter from the outside, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, moved to put that one to test leaving the three-eighth pole, grabbed a narrow advantage, turned for home under urging, and with several rivals in close pursuit, got hooked up in a skirmish with the top one, fought it out gamely to the end, but lost the bob. SMART ENUF was rated in the two path until the five-sixteenths pole, then displayed a good kick to earn the show. IGOTURBACK was unhurried while saving ground, took off with sudden acceleration, in the two path, upon reaching the quarter pole, was forced to pause momentarily when a tiring GAP CLOSER took away that lane in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, squeezed by that rival a jump later to continue the bid, loomed a serious threat inside the top two with an eighth to go, but soon flattened out. TYPHOON TYCOON was placed widest of all down the backstretch, attempted to reach the front with a four wide sweep around the far turn, but wasn't up to the task. GAP CLOSER rated inside, gave way by upper stretch. STOPBLUFFING underwent a three wide journey and was reported to have bled.
