Footnotes

ALL JONESY out a bit at the start, bumped hard with BIG FOOT BEN, bounced off that foe and went on to assume a forward position, ranged up towards the leader shortly after entering the turn, took over in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, using basically her own power and contrasting tactics being used by the rider of the former leader, entered the stretch and got let out, scampered away to a more comfortable advantage during the ensuing furlong, squandered none of it proceeding from the eighth pole to the wire. BEDOUIN NOW was put to urging nearly from the get-go giving chase from along the outside, had the rider refrain from encouragement only from the seven-sixteenths pole to midpoint, got outfinished by the top one. BIG FOOT BEN was bumped soundly from between rivals at the start, rallied into contention travelling three wide on the turn, was under a drive spinning into the lane when he made solid contact with MOONLITE ENCOUNTER just to the inside at that juncture, flattened out in the final furlong. CONCORDE'S PEACE put to some hustling along the backstretch, never made it out the back of the pack in the initial stages, began to pick up the pace late on the turn, swung four wide into upper stretch and mustered up a mild response to mainly go by weak and tired ones. CHAMBERS BAY took the inside route until upper stretch, ran around the turn under some urging, was coming up to another's heels approaching the quarter pole and had the rider steady as a precautionary measure, was taken out to the two path in two stages during the stretch drive, came up empty. MOONLITE ENCOUNTER made contact with BIGFOOT BEN at the break and once more as the pair turned for home, tired after racing from off the rail throughout. GOLDCRAFT grabbed the early advantage, was kept off the rail until the end of the backstretch, was put to some encouragement yet relinquished readily to an asked rival late on the bend, retreated after entering the stretch.
