SIERO between foes just off the inside just off the pace, came under urging three furlongs out, spun three wide for home, rallied through the stretch to be the outermost of four across the track battling seventy yards from the wire, surged by in the final strides to prevail. TWEET ME broke out at the start and was corrected before any contact could be made, got hustled to be on the pace along the inside pressured by RAMBLING on the outside, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside for home, was headed at the three-sixteenths and had his main foe inch away to the eighth pole, battled on to come on again in the final seventy yards to regain the place honors. MY WAY OR DUBAIWAY hesitated slightly at the start getting off half a beat slow, tracked the front along the rail urged from the three-eighths pole, offered up a mild kick to be the innermost of a quartet across the track seventy yards out, dug in to procure the show. RAMBLING hustled from the start, prompted the pace two to three wide, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, rallied to take command at the three-sixteenths, inched away slightly to the furlong grounds, dug in confronted by a trio through to the wire and was outfinished late on. GRAND AWARD three wide in pursuit from close range, came under encouragement three furlongs out, cornered four wide in upper stretch and offered no response.
