CUVEE CITY three wide in close pursuit initially, confronted the leader shifted to the two path as TISH'S BAD BOY backed out at the three-eighths pole, dueled from there to the quarter pole seizing a slight advantage at that station, edged clear under a drive kept to task to the wire. SHOT ROCK on the pace inside under some pressure early on, got confronted midway on the turn, dueled with the aforementioned rival to the quarter pole, got shaken off at that station, kept on with good energy to secure the place unable to match the top one in the final eighth. PEGASUS T lunged at the start bumping RETIRED, settled four wide just off the pace under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide into the lane, offered up a mild kick for the show. LAST RUN just off the inside in mid pack, got coaxed along from the seven-sixteenths, spun three wide in upper stretch, offered up a belated kick and just missed for the show honors. NIGHT EDITOR hustled from the start, chased just off the inside just off the pace, got ridden along from three furlongs out, offered up a mild bid through the stretch but was out kicked. TISH'S BAD BOY hustled from the gate, prompted the pace early on from just off the inside between foes, faded nearing the three-eighths pole, was placed to urging at that station, and weakened thereafter. RETIRED bumped at the start by PEGASUS T who lunged inwards, settled three wide towards the rear, got ridden along from midway on the turn, cornered four wide in upper stretch and offered no response. SUMMER HAASIENDA four wide towards the rear urged along from three furlongs out, swung five wide in upper stretch, offered no kick. GET OFF THE STOOP saved ground throughout pushed along from midway on the turn and trailed.
