BRIDGEVILLE prompted GOLDEN DOC while racing from off the inside, made a successful challenge midway around the second bend, turned for home with none latched on and got set down, reached the wire in time to prevail. EIGHT CENTS broke awkwardly inward leaving the starting gate, was guided over to the rail well before the end of the homestretch, vacated the premises midpoint on the backstretch, got put to encouragement, kicked in with some belated energy, but fell short. LIGHTNING RON tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, angled out into the two path to move by the now-tiring former pacesetter approaching the five-sixteenths marker, lacked a solid closing response. TONY D strung out three wide on the opening bend, tired. BUDDY'S SMART raced from off the inside, drifted six wide into the stretch while tiring. GOLDEN DOC was gunned from the starting gate to establish command, made it over to the rail before reaching the beginning of the first turn, succumbed to the winner without much resistance when challenged midway on the far turn and faded. TALON'S PAPA never in contention, got eased.
