POINTS WEST was hustled up inside, contested the pace, dug in gamely when roused and drew away under a drive. SKIP QUEEN contested the pace while three wide, could not stay with the winner in the stretch and continued on to hold the place spot. POSSIBILITY was outrun early, raced inside and offered a mild rally on the rail. ESTHER'S STAR raced close up while three wide, chased the pace and tired in the stretch. SICILIAN PRINCESS raced between rivals and tired. BUTTERFACE contested the pace while between rivals and tired after a half mile. GUESTBOOK was outrun along the inside.
