**Footnotes**

MITIGATION left the starting gate alertly, contested the pace from the two path, lightly coaxed to maintain interest, took over and began to shake free late on the turn, entered the stretch and got called upon, increased the advantage during the ensuing furlong, held a healthy margin to the end, crossing the finish under a brisk hand ride. CALLMETONY got off a beat slowly, brought up the back of the pack placed slightly off the inside, was let out a notch and picked up interest coming to the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home from the four path and commenced to rally in earnest, displayed a good kick down the center of the strip to take the place, although never posing a serious threat to the winner. EON moved up along the rail grab a forward position, argued for control with the top one, fell back slightly leaving the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive soon afterwards, but was no longer able to keep pace, weakening eventually into the show slot. HALF A NOTE chased the pace combatants from the outside, failed to muster up a solid closing punch after entering the stretch. I'VE GOT THE FEVER broke inward, was taken in hand but not before bobbling, settled near the inside, angled outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, beating HALF A NOTE to the three path in the process, came up empty.
