Footnotes

HAYA'S BOY came in slightly at the start, yet still grabbed a forward position, pressed the issue from the three path throughout most of the opening half, crept up to the pacesetter leaving the five-sixteenths pole, and turned for home trailing by about a neck, got put to a hard drive, once settled into upper stretch, poked a head down in front at the eighth pole, had the stretch duel continue, showed good determination to fend off an equally determined rival for the decision. COOPER RIVER broke away from the starting in good fashion and was hand urged to establish control, sat entrenched in the two path, felt increased pressure from the closest pursuer late on the turn, approached the quarter pole having lost almost all of his advantage and was set down, with the eventual winner following suit one jump later, fell back slightly during the run through the furlong grounds, gallantly fought back to regain the top during the last eighth pole, but was held off successfully. MAKE NOTE down along the rail in the initial stages, chose the two path for the run around the bend, stalked the front runners from there, swung into the lane and was asked for a response, gained some ground making his way from upper to midstretch, altered course in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, wound drifting outward some three paths, got straightened away and came home with strong late foot in the final seventy yards. PRECIOUS METAL raced three wide, failed to make up much ground on the embattled first two place finishers in the initial portion of the stretch run, then got herded outward a few paths in deep stretch by MAKE NOTE. JUPITER TRIO saved ground, the only member of the body to do so, was under some urging by the midway point on the turn, but could make no headway on the front runners. AL'S DEPUTY off the inside, was placed four wide at the head of the stretch, had no response.
