FASHION'S FLIGHT sat within range three wide on the turn, challenged in earnest approaching the top of the stretch, gained ground readily down the center of the track making her way to the furlong marker, forged to the front about a sixteenth down the road and edged away, kept busy to the end. RIBOLETTI settled near the inside soon after the start, cut the pace, rating kindly and with UNRIVALED SCORE applying pressure directly to the outside, continued along on the same scenario for three-quarters, felt the presence of additional challengers, one to his inside and the other to the outside, and got asked for a response, clung desperately to a narrow advantage during the next furlong, yielded to the top one for good with about a sixteenth to go, but continued onward willingly to secure second. NEBRASKA contently tracked the front runners from the inside, found sufficient clearance down along the fence to launch a run from the quarter pole, loomed boldly by the eighth pole, but could not sustain the move. UNRIVALED SCORE ducked inward at the break, recovered and went on to secure up a forward post, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside for the opening six furlongs, failed to fire when called upon spinning into the stretch. STEAL THE DANCE placed four wide at the three-eighths pole, trailed.
