Footnotes

COROFIN broke out at the start and was corrected, came under light hand urging to establish the front then was placed under a light hold once there, set the pace from the two path under patient handling until the three-sixteenths, felt the presence of the runner up at that station and was set down for the drive, ran on through the furlong grounds holding his nearest rival at bay while kept to task driving. GOODTIME BOY tracked the front from inside saving ground until the top of the lane, angled out to the three path after straightening away under a drive, came home with good energy to secure the place cutting into the winner's margin through the final eighth. HANDSOME HARBOR tossed his head right at the start and was off slightly awkward at the start, raced three wide through the turn under light coaxing to keep pace, swung four wide at the top of the stretch, was set down for the drive, steadily gained through the lane for show honors unable to threaten the top pair. JET SET CAT reserved off the pace in the two path in midpack, came under light coaxing midway on the turn, was roused at the head of the lane, angled out one path for a clear lane at the three-sixteenths, displayed a mild bid through the lane never threatening the top while clear for the last major share. COPPER TIGER off a step slow at the start, saved ground throughout the turn, came under a drive at the quarter pole, finished evenly through the lane while along the inside throughout. HAPPY HIGH chased three wide until the quarter pole, swung out widest at that station, five wide, and offered no response. TAX RETURN chased the front three wide and prominent for a half and gave way. TERMINUS off a beat slow, was allowed to settle towards the rear, came under a drive at the head of the lane and offered little.
