WINLOC'S JOHN LEE contested the pace from the outside, kicked clear approaching the quarter pole and was set down to a drive, emerged from the furlong grounds holding a comfortable advantage and extended it, crossing the wire under strong hand encouragement. KEYALY brought up the rear of the pack while racing along the inside for nearly a half, got taken gradually further and further to the outside after turning for home, was eventually seven wide and the widest of all by the eighth pole, continued on with good energy to garner the place. INQUEST three wide at the three-eighths pole, rallied to secure the show. PAPA FREUD bobbled at the start, improved position with a mild stretch response. S. Z. MADISON three wide, had no rally. HAVING A NICE TIME underwent a three wide pursuit, was roused coming to the five-sixteenths pole, remained a forward factor until midstretch before backing away. BARNARDS GALAXY was taken over to the rail by the half mile pole, argued for control with the runner up then gave way. NO MORE TAXES four wide departing the backstretch, folded. NATIVE BREEZE tracked inside and faded.
