**Footnotes**

SUPERSTITIOUS LOVE kicked clear of the others soon after the start and was guided over to the inside, extended the margin during the run around the bend, doing so under her own power, turned for home in possession of her biggest advantage, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before having the rider switch over to a drive, saw the lead cut down in size rapidly in the late stages, but held on safely. NIGHT BRIGADE brushed with SILVER OVER GOLD very shortly after the start, was unhurried along the outside during the initial stages, picked up interest late on the turn, fanned outward until about four wide by the three-sixteenths pole, displayed strong belated foot en route to procuring the place. SMARTY BULL saved ground throughout, proved no match for the top pair in the final furlong. JOLIENNE stumbled at the start, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, weakened after entering the stretch. SILVER OVER GOLD made light contact with the second place finisher right after the start, raced from off the inside, had the rider grab hold briefly as a precautionary measure going by the fallen rider in upper stretch, lacked the needed closing response. SALVAR was three wide departing the backstretch, swung slightly wider into the stretch, drifted inward a bit after the second of two light taps on the right shoulder as BEPPJ came outward even less so at the same time, got clipped from behind by BORN FLIRT, who was at that time a short distance behind the pair, had no rally. BEPPJ gave chase along the outside under encouragement on the turn, tired. BORN FLIRT was lightly bumped from both side soon after the break, raced from off the rail, coaxed along to keep pace, stumbled after clipping the heels of SALVAR in upper stretch, losing the rider as a result. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident in upper stretch before the result was declared official.
