EXTINGUISH broke sharply from the starting gate, found himself locked up in a speed tussle with GRACEFUL AFLEET from the get go, battled for the lead from the two path with that rival until turning for home, gained a slim advantage after being straightened away, then extended her winning margin while being kept busy to the end. DELASTMANSTANDING sat perched, within striking distance, off the pace fight during the initial half, watched the top off draw off after entering the stretch but continued on well to clearly best the others for the place. GRACEFUL AFLEET dueled for the lead along the inside until the quarter pole and gave way. BELIEVE IN LOVE well placed along the inside, lacked a rally. MR. VANTASTIC was no factor. CROMWELL ALLEY failed to reach contention. MINNIE PUNT was no menace. SAY HALO SANDY reserved off the inside, gave way after going a half. BLOW UP was outrun.
