FULL OF INTENT grabbed a forward position soon after the start, patiently prompted the leader from the outside, overhauled HOOK IT UP on her own power upon reaching the turn, and was guided over to the inside coming to the three-eighths pole, was put to a vigorous hand ride in upper stretch, drew out to a commanding lead by the time she hit the eighth pole, was steadily geared down the remainder of the way, yet stayed comfortably in front nonetheless. GRANBY GIRL unhurried in the initial stages, was asked to pick up the pace in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, spun four wide into the stretch and came home with good energy to be clearly second best. GLYNISTHEMENCE off the inside, was under a full drive by the five-sixteenths pole, folded. BENIMARI left the rail late on the turn, tired. MARLINS ROSE three wide on the turn, gave way. PROUD SIREN cut the corner under a drive and flattened out. HOOK IT UP showed the way from the inside, offered no resistance when confronted by the winner, then retreated.
