CASH FOR CLUNKERS away in good order, sat chilly in the two path until the half mile pole, cruised up towards the pacesetter from the outside during the run around the turn, poked a head in front as the two front runners entered the stretch and had the rider release a good grip on the reins, lengthened away proceeding her way to the finish line, both hand urged and cross reined, got successfully geared down at the sixteenth pole and completed the race unasked for speed. COCO ECOLO coaxed along while taking the inside route, rallied for the place. STEPHANIE JAYNE bobbled at the start, gave chase from off the inside, proved no match for the top twosome during the stretch run. LEMON TIGER failed to menace. EDEN STAR well out in the track down the chute, settled along the rail early on the backstretch, set the opening splits on an open lead, continued along on the same scenario for almost five furlongs, got overhauled by the winner approaching the quarter pole and faltered.
