QUIET POWER in a step at the start, was pulled off the nearest opponent before significant contact could be made, settled into midpack making his way down the chute, patiently stalked the fighting front runners under a good hold from the two path, availed of the opportunity to get placed three wide in preparation for the stretch drive at the five-sixteenths pole, spun from there under encouragement into the lane and took off in earnest after the duelers, went by each to take over before reaching the eighth pole, dug in well enough at the end to turn back the belated bid from TAP ATTACK. TAP ATTACK three wide, trailed for nearly three-quarters, was under a right handed whip turning for home, got straightened away and came home with good energy to miss. MERIDIAN MAGIC departed the backstretch three wide, held his ground well in the final furlong to secure the show. HURLING was guided into the two path just before reaching the turn, picked up the pace nearing the quarter pole, got called upon in upper stretch and rallied to grab the last major check. EMINENT TALE left alertly and secured a forward position, fought on nearly even terms with HARDSHELL for most of the opening quarter, shook that one off only to get hooked up by the rail-skimming CONGO, raced heads apart with that foe until just past the five-sixteenths pole, edged away while being asked for run at the station, entered the stretch with the eventual winner in hot pursuit, was unable to hold that rival off, relinquishing during the run through the furlong grounds, weakened steadily in the last eighth. CONGO advanced along the rail to take on EMINENT TALE shortly after reaching the backstretch, raced on nearly terms until late on the turn, was the first of two to commit to some kind of urging, gave way after turning for home. ARTIE LUVSTO PARTY saved ground and was through after completing six furlongs. HARDSHELL broke on top and sparred with EMINENT TALE in the early going, dropped back slightly, despite being put to some urging, chased an embattled pair three wide making his way to the half mile pole and beyond, drifted four wide showing signs of weariness leaving the midway point on the turn, drifted outward even more entering the stretch and faded.
