CHASING MOONLIGHT sat perched from the three path keeping a watch on the embattled pair just up ahead, ranged up once CYBERTRON fell back in the vicinity of five-sixteenths pole, waited for the rest of the way around the turn before getting called upon, blew by GANADOR approaching the end of the furlong grounds, was kept to a strong drive before finally getting geared down in the final seventy yards. ROCK STAR CHARLIE saved ground throughout, launched a successful rail rally down the stretch to procure the place. D' SAUVAGE leaned upon by rivals from each side after the break, got squeezed back, departed the backstretch from the three path and remained well off the rail the entire time on the bend, swung four wide into the stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. GANADOR dueled from along the outside, arguing with CYBERTRON while being lightly hand urged, had the top one make his presence felt by the quarter pole and was asked for much more, relinquished soon afterwards and backed away. MISSILEWHILEUWORK off the inside, chased the ongoing pace on the turn, was already under solid encouragement taking the three path for entrance into the stretch, gave way. CHASIN THE CASH brushed at the start, fanned five wide into the stretch, failed to menace. CYBERTRON came out a bit at the start, bumped lightly with the nearest opponent, then leaned upon that rival for a couple of jumps before being pulled away, moved up willingly to tackle with the early leader, sparred from the outside with the foe until about the quarter pole and folded.
