KARA'S MATCH POINT made solid contact with SATURDAY NTHE PARK just after the start, tracked the front runners while riding the rail, was put to urging and got angled outward approaching the head of the stretch, had the rider take hold then got placed into the three path at the three-sixteenths pole, settled into her best stride and took off in earnest after the second place finisher, drew on even terms with about seventy yards remaining, took over in short order and edged away. SATURDAY NTHE PARK bumped with the winner at the start, went to gain the early advantage and was sent over to the inside, raced as a team with MADRE DITUTTICAPI parked out in the two path, being the more asked of the pair, headed for home clinging to the narrowest of leads and was called upon for her best, gave it, shaking off her nemesis during the ensuing furlong, had the top one make her presence soon afterwards, lost the lead in the final seventy yards and had to settle for the place. MASASI brushed at the start, chased three wide on the turn, displayed a good kick down the center of the strip en route for the show. MADRE DITUTTICAPI the only member of the field to be without anything of note to report at the break, assumed a forward position, drew alongside the runner up and initiated a more intense pace dispute by the top of the turn, was on nearly even terms and still under a firm hold nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch and got set down, raced side by side with SATURDAY NTHE PARK for about another sixteenth before backing away. TURBOENCABULATOR came out of the starting gate in a straight line, went onward for a couple of jumps then ducked sharply to the outward, departed the backstretch from the four path and remained out there around the turn, failed to reach a contending position. SKY RIVER bobbed after making light contact with MASASI, was given some gentle motivation near the right shoulder with the stick but failed to move inward, got taken outward thereafter instead, strode greenly at times, was well off the inside at the half mile pole but about two wide by the top of the lane, reacted greenly weaving back and forth shying from the whip, both as it was being used or just being flashed, down the lane. GOLD LADY bobbed inward as the field was sent on its way, sat forwardly placed in the initial stages, fell back steadily from the top of the bend to its end, was under a full drive cutting the corner into the lane, faltered.
