TIGER TANK lost his footing at the start recovering inwards and bumping FERLIN HUSKY, ranged up in tandem with MAXIMUS MIKE to vie from the two path between foes nearing the half mile pole, took over the front into the turn, shook away briefly unhurried by midway, came under challenge nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner roused for home, edged clear under a drive, got shown the stick to the offside when getting out slightly to the wire kept to task. FERLIN HUSKY bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe when that rival recovered his footing, came under hustling to show the way early on, got joined by a pair nearing the half mile pole and was headed for the front into the turn, tracked inside through the turn coming under urging just inside the five-sixteenths, angled three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the place honors. QUI C'EST MOI just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun four wide into upper stretch, kept on evenly through the lane to garner the show honors. MAXIMUS MIKE stumbled slightly at the start, ranged up in tandem with TIGER TANK to threaten the leader at the half mile pole, raced three wide in aim through the turn, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, launched a mild bid shifting to the two path to threaten the front nearing the quarter pole, cornered just off the inside for home and weakened in the stretch. KNOX broke in at the start and was corrected, settled two to three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs out and trailed throughout.
