MEWANNAROSE pressed the issue from the two path, took over in upper stretch, dug in willingly to preserve a narrow lead. CRAFTY DREAMER was coaxed along while tracking the front runners from the inside, angled sharply three wide in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, closed in well en route to securing second. BOBBY V. stacked four wide at the half mile pole, continued from well off the inside, held on well for the show. GOMBEBY DANCER coaxed along while clutching a slim lead, got asked for more heading home, lost the fight with the winner racing through the furlong grounds, weakened in the final furlong. CAST A DOUBT three wide on the turn, got fanned into the five path coming to the eighth pole, had no late response. GHOST HUNTER raced three wide on the bend, waited briefly behind rivals approaching the quarter pole, failed to fire appreciably when called upon. MUCH STRONGER between rivals on the turn, gave way. IN THE DARK broke in the air, saved ground and trailed.
