DON SIX quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and remained safely clear under a drive. INTELLIGENT MALE was hustled along early, rallied inside nearing the stretch, angled out and finished gamely. QUIGLEY was outrun early, advanced four wide nearing the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. ELUSIVE GENTLEMAN was outrun early, came wide for the drive and had no rally. CRAFTY SONG raced inside and had no response when roused. LIVING SINGLE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. SUPERLANG chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. SUNSHINE BRIAN chased the pace along the inside and tired after a half mile.
