E Z PASSER sat within range off the inside during the opening half, took the three path for run around the second bend, was asked for run turning for home from there, gained readily on the embattled pair up ahead, with PELICAN LAKE making a similar move, but much closer to the inside, wrested away command in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, edged clear, then drifted out several paths when given one parting left handed shot prior to reaching the finish line. ALYKELA off the inside and unhurried, finished with good energy down the outside to garner place honors. CHEROKEE TRICK fought it out for the lead with PUT ME FIRST, traversing in the two path, gained a narrow lead after putting away the aforementioned rival as that twosome neared the furlong marker, but with a pair of rivals in hot pursuit, held her ground well for about another sixteenth, gave in to the top one's challenge, but continued on willingly to earn the show. PELICAN LAKE down along the rail, behaved rankly, offering resistance to the rating tactics being applied by the rider, acted more professionally when released from that grip and put to light coaxing, bided time for nearly three-quarters, found sufficient room to ease outward at the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch two wide, gained readily during the run through the furlong grounds, before flattening out a bit the final sixteenth. SEEING CLEARLY three wide around both turns, tired. SISTER IN THE CITY three wide around the far turn, was no factor. PUT ME FIRST off alertly, angled over to the inside, reaching it before reaching the first turn, disputed the pace while taking the inside route, kept up the fight until midstretch and faltered.
