**Footnotes**

STAR OF NEW YORK sat within range from off the inside, picked up interest late on the turn, was under a drive taking the three path into the stretch, collared the leader and appeared to poke a head down in front at the eighth pole, shadowed rival outward a couple of paths, yet tenaciously clung to a narrow advantage all the while, had the runner up resume a straighter course in short order, dug in gamely to the end to preserve the decision. MANTECA assumed a forward spot soon after the start, prompted the pacesetter parked just off the leader's hind quarters from the two path, lightly coaxed to maintain interest, drew alongside coming to midpoint on the turn, went by, still unasked for speed, to lead the field into the stretch by a slim margin, got put to a drive in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole just at the top one was making his presence felt, came outward a couple of paths while battling on even terms in midstretch, after being fed a steady diet of left handed shots, was switched over to right handed tactics and put back on a truer course, battled gamely to the end, but couldn't regain the lead. GROOMEDFORVICTORY had control by the end of the chute, set the initial splits from the inside, constantly tugging on the left side of the bit, had the second place finisher draw abreast early on the turn, yielded to the confidently handled rival before reaching the quarter pole, faded into show slot after departing the furlong grounds. SUN DANCE MOON three wide on the turn, had little left for the stretch run. JOE VANN trailed throughout off a ground-saving journey.
