**Footnotes**

DADS CAPS bumped at the start when GO CANES GO broke outwards awkwardly, settled on the pace along the inside racing in hand, got set down at the quarter pole bracing for a challenge from TENANGO, inched away to the eighth pole repulsing that bid, held sway to the wire drifting out in the late stages to the wire. TENANGO just off the pace tracking from just off the inside, got let out at the quarter pole mounting a challenge on the leader, rallied with good energy widening away in tandem from the remainder of the field through the stretch, got repulsed to the wire being kept at bay by the aforementioned foe. GO CANES GO broke out awkwardly at the start bumping DADS CAPS, tracked the pace along the inside, got asked at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane, kept on mildly through the stretch unable to threaten the top pair while clear of the rest. KILLIN ME SMALLS broke out at the start and was taken briefly in hand to avoid striking GO CANES GO, raced keen early on resisting the rider, settled better just off the inside into the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home, offered no response and weakened in the drive. BYE BYE BERNIE stumbled at the start, settled two to three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch and tired.
