BIG SCREEN contently prompted the pacesetter from the two path until midway down the backstretch, coaxed along to maintain interest while doing so, shadowed the leader outward at that juncture to take up residence in the three path and remained parked out in that path during the run around the far turn, ranged up and grabbed the narrowest of leads as the top twosome spun into the stretch, got put to a drive and scampered away comfortably making his way through the furlong grounds, had the pilot flash the whip from the right side, then got switched over to a vigorous hand ride at the sixteenth pole, was kept to it to the end drawing away decisively. SAILMATE raced along the outside, was under a drive coming four wide into the stretch, proved no match. REGAL WARRIOR off a beat slowly, quickly tucked along the inside, rode the rail for nearly six furlongs, was angled three wide into the lane, lacked the needed response. PUNSTER outran a pair of opponents en route to securing the front, was rated along towards the inside while cutting the pace, got out slightly and went on to be two wide about halfway down the backstretch, with the winner shortly being maneuvered to the outside as well, remained off the rail the rest of the way to the half mile pole and on the second turn, was put to the test by the top one nearing the quarter pole, relinquished after putting up a brief fight, then steadily tired. NACHO BUSINESS three wide until the five-sixteenths marker, folded.
