REIN KING contently prompted the leader from off the inside, challenged in earnest and grabbed a narrow lead as the field headed for home, drew off to win by a comfortable advantage. MAGIC HARBOR unhurried while racing along the outside, picked up the pace upon departing the backstretch, split rivals in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker while advancing into contention, drifted inward in upper stretch, with head tilted heavily towards the right side while doing so, failed to keep up with the top one then just held the place. THIS HARD LAND saved ground for nearly three-quarters, was under urging getting angled three wide into the stretch, got straightened away and mustered up a mild response that fell just short of securing second. READTHEBYLINE vied to maintain control from the rail, was put to a stern test by the winner nearing the top of the lane, relinquished soon afterwards and backed away. IRISH LION saved ground and faltered. AVENGING SPIRIT broke in the air, sputtered three wide into the opening bend, tugging noticeably on the left side of the bit, was coaxed along down the backstretch while staying within striking distance, travelled in the three path around the far turn, once more tugging on the left side of the bit, lost his action entering the stretch, got eased, then was quickly pulled up.
