ANNIES PROSPECT contested the pace along the inside and dug in gamely in the stretch. BRAZILIAN BABY broke awkwardly, was hustled up inside, chased the pace along the rail and lacked a rally. PRINCESS A. P. raced three wide and had no rally. EMMA M. raced inside and had no response when roused. PANINA broke slowly, raced greenly while very wide and tired in the stretch. SWEET GRAND raced greenly inside and was steadied entering the turn. WATRALS BASHFULL showed speed from the outside and tired after a half mile.
