SMAX sprinted clear on the rail, dug in when challenged on the turn, fought gamely into deep stretch and prevailed after a hard drive. GAME TOKEN stalked three wide for most of the pace, drew on even terms with the winner in midstretch and was outfinished late. MENDELSSOHN well placed, saved ground just behind the leaders, waited on the turn then swung four wide and finished willingly. ST. AUGUSTINE pressed the winner between horses to the top of the stretch and weakened. BINDLE STICK raced five wide in midpack at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. BUDGET was outrun along the inside. ROYAL LORD trailed most of the trip.
