DIAMOND DISTRICT was well placed, rallied three wide at the quarter pole and edged clear under steady urging. NEXT DAY was reserved for a mile then closed late from outside to gain the place. FRENCH TRANSITION battled along the rail into upper stretch and weakened. ENDLESS CIRCLE saved ground to the turn, angled between horses and finished evenly. SOUTH FOURTH ST. dueled in the two path to the top of the stretch and tired. NO HALO ON ME in hand early, never reached contention. EARLY RESPONSE stumbled at the start then saved ground to no avail.
