Footnotes

BARNIE'S BULLET vied three wide for the lead, went at it in earnest with MR. GRIEVANCE after turning for home, poked a head in front at the eighth pole and edged clear under a drive. ZIO TONY left the backstretch from the four path, continued along the widest of all around the turn, was set down to a hard drive after straightening away in the lane, then outkicked the former pacesetter for the place. MR. GRIEVANCE hand urged to the front from the starting gate, was still put to some light coaxing after grabbing the early lead, was pressed by the top one during the run the around the bend, turned for home under encouragement, gearing up for the upcoming battle with the top one, fought well, before relinquishing the lead approaching the eighth pole, and steadily weakened thereafter. DONTQUITYOURDAYJOB took up residence along the inside, outrun for nearly a half, was taken outward nearing the quarter pole, commenced his rally placed four wide at the head of the stretch and mustered up enough of a kick to improve position. LINEAR MOTION raced along the outside, was asked for run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, but failed to respond. MAGIC MAX saved ground until upper stretch and was never a factor.
