Footnotes

WEE FREUDIAN settled into midpack soon after the start, was asked for some run to keep pace during the run around the bend, went after the leader in earnest after entering the stretch, grabbed the lead away by the eighth pole, then drew away under hand encouragement. SAY GOODBYE got off to a sharp start, and was eased into the two path early down the backstretch, cut the pace, under a good hold and uncontested on the turn, spurted away, still under his own courage, approaching the head of the stretch, was given his cue nearing the three-sixteenths pole, failed to keep pace with the top one, squandering what was once at one time a comfortable advantage, left the furlong grounds, slightly behind WEE FREUDIAN, dropped back even further from that point, but had plenty left to salvage the place. HAYA'S BOY stumbled badly at the start, causing the rider to jump up in the saddle and lose the left iron for a stride or two, had the rider regain it before angling over to the rail, saved ground around the turn, was roused after entering the stretch but lacked the needed response to reel either of the top twosome. REPETAL lacked early foot, swung four wide into the stretch, was herded out a couple of paths farther to the outside by DR.MULLINAN in upper stretch, then went on to improve position by weak and tired ones. DR. MULLIGAN off the inside, was through after completing a half. MY PAL S. P. placed four wide at the three-eighths pole, tired. PETEY CRAMER three wide, was coaxed giving chase on the leader and folded.
