SHE'S FIRED UP away well, left the rail just prior to reaching the first turn, swung three wide into the backstretch, gradually advanced towards the pacesetter, continued to make steady progress, still three wide, during the run around the second bend, turned for home under encouragement, closed in on the new leader, drifted out a couple of paths in response to heavy right handed pressure, just as she grabbing the front, departing the sixteenth pole, was put back on an truer course after being switched to a combination of left handed stick work and whip flashing and held sway. MINT JULIET was off a beat slowly, after being lightly bumped on both sides soon after leaving the gate, lost her stride momentarily, got going again and motored into midpack without need of much urging, taking the inside route, remained unhurried for nearly three-quarters, angled outward in upper stretch, was roused and rallied willingly to procure the place. KITTY'S THUNDER away well, took up the role of stalker, came out over two paths early down the backstretch, taking the top one along for the ride, settled to be two wide by the half mile pole, ranged up to the pacesetter, challenged in earnest leaving the five-sixteenths pole, quickly gained command, was soon put to the test by the top one, yielded a short distance from the sixteenth pole and weakened into the third slot. SKY FEVER bumped lightly with the runner up just after the start, trailed for the opening six furlongs,angled three wide for the stretch drive, but lacked the needed response. SHADY ROAD was pulled off a rival after attempting to break inward, made her way to the front and briefly shook free of the competition, felt some pressure nearing the half mile, was let out but readily yielded at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter.
