Footnotes

TATTOOED BY RICK chased the front three wide, came under hand coaxing at the five-sixteenths, progressed on the front and took command at the head of the lane, was let out shortly thereafter and edged away, grew leg weary in the last few strides while kept to task and prevailed safely. MISS SILVER BIRCH reserved off the pace and saving ground throughout, came under a drive at the head of the lane, angled out for a clear path at the eighth pole, shied from the left handed whip through the final furlong while rallying readily for the place honors. MAYBRY'S GOLD pressed the pace inside initially until about the seven-sixteenths, opted to take back at that juncture and mount a bid from the two path challenging the front from her outside through the turn, came under a drive at the top of the stretch, rallied mildly no match for the top two, flattening out late while well clear for show honors. ONE OR THE OTHER unhurried in the early stages, raced two to three wide through the turn, came under encouragement at the midway point, shifted four wide at the quarter pole and bid mildly by tired foes in the lane. CUTE set the pace from the two path initially until the seven-sixteenths when her inside rival opted to take back briefly, raced through the turn along the rail thereafter, began to be pushed along under pressure coming to the quarter pole, was displaced at that station and steadily faded. RAINBOW GAL off a step slow, saved ground throughout, came under a long drive from the three-eighths and offered no kick. MY LEONORA took the overland route throughout and never menaced. FIFTYFIVEFIFTYFIVE hustled from the gate, raced four wide in the turn, was pushed along from midway and was no factor.
