Footnotes

RISKY RACHEL the early leader, conceded the advantage to SALTAMONTES shortly before reaching the half mile pole, had that rival tuck along the rail and was immediately placed in the two path, ranged up to apply pressure by the seven-sixteenths pole, bided time keeping pace directly alongside the leader, moved when ready and looked that opponent in the eye in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, edged away to narrow lead as the field headed for the top of the lane then got set down, extended the lead during the ensuing furlong, continued to add to the winning margin, drifting out steadily throughout much of the stretch run. BIG BROWNIE settled into midpack, raced from off the inside, was asked for a response by five-sixteenths pole, headed for home two wide and under a full drive, rallied to garner the place, although never posing a serious threat to the winner. NICOLE'S MISS EL underwent a three wide pursuit and got out finished. LADY GRACENOTE took the inside route until the quarter pole, was on the receiving of some light hand coaxing almost from the get-go, yet lagged behind, swung four wide into upper stretch, lacked a solid offering. SALTAMONTES worked her way gradually to the front with cooperation coming from the rider of the top one, was sent over to rail once sufficiently clear, this occurring near the end of the backstretch, felt the presence of the winner during the run around the bend, yielded prior to the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. DEVILISH SPIRIT placed at a slight distance from off the rail on the turn, was through after completing a half. VICTORYAT LAST saved ground while trailing throughout.
