THE RHYTHMISRIGHT established control in short order, set the pace, rated along the inside and facing no resistance, completed the half in front by a comfortable advantage, more than doubled it lightly urged from upper to midstretch, then added to the winning margin, never full extended at any moment. SIDEARM came out briefly midway down the backstretch, with the pilot answering it with some stick work near the area of the right shoulder, raced towards the inside, gained the place after getting put to a prolonged drive. FORGED saved ground, was under encouragement on the turn, got outfinished. LET'S DISCUSS chased the top one from the two path and gave way. SOCIAL REBELLION three wide and roused by the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. THREE FOR ME was driven three wide into the stretch, tired. NOON SHADOW lightly bumped while momentarily jostled between rivals at the end of the backstretch, was guided over to the inside route past the midway point on the turn, folded.
