MESS IN A DRESS broke alertly, maintained the advantage, showed the way at or near the inside, got pounced upon by the runner up as three-quarters was being completed, was asked for a run as a spirited tussle between the pair began, came up the victor, kicking away the final furlong. GO OLIVIA GO stalked the winner from the two path, picked up interest when asked leaving the backstretch, drew alongside the top one by the five-sixteenths marker, sparred on even terms to midstretch, got shaken off but continued onward in a willing manner to be well clear of the others for the place. EZPZ LEMON SQUEEZE bumped early, was under strong handling by the half mile pole, gained the show. E Z PASSER saved ground to the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch to no avail. TAYLOR JAGGER bumped early, raced three wide on the opening bend, was closer to the rail on the subsequent one, tired. BOZIQUE gently pinched back approaching the end of the homestretch, saved ground on both turns, gave way.
