Footnotes

STORIED LADY threw her head at the start then was squeezed back between foes both breaking her way, tracked the pace inside in range, was patiently handled to the quarter pole, got roused briefly then paused off heels in behind rivals to the eighth pole altered inside at that station commencing encouragement, came on through down on the rail and seized command nearing the sixteenth marker, edged away in the late stages to prevail. MLLE. MINUIT just off the inside at the rear initially, shifted to the four path at the half mile pole, commenced a three to four wide bid on the front from the seven-sixteenths joined in tandem by SARATOGA SHOES inside to threaten LADY LUCIANO by the three-eighths, vied outside that pair to the quarter pole, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, dug in rallying to seize narrow command a furlong out, got displaced a sixteenth from home kicking on readily clear for the place and second best. BRIDGET MOLONEY cut the pace inside in hand early on, got confronted by a pair at the seven-sixteenths and vied inside those foes through the far turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch, dug in under threat from a trio to the eighth pole and was headed at that station, weakened in the final sixteenth and preserved the show. SARATOGA SHOES broke in at the start bumping and squeezing STORIED LADY back in tandem with LADY LUCIANO, raced three wide in pursuit early on, shifted to the two path at the seven-sixteenths and bid in tandem with MLLE. MINUIT on the front, vied between foes through the turn coming under a drive at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, weakened in the stretch. LADY LUCIANO broke out at the start bumping and squeezing STORIED LADY back in tandem with SARATOGA SHOES, attended the pace from just off the inside, lost position unable to quicken enough at the half mile pole as SARATOGA SHOES took over the path and bid in tandem with MLLE. MINUIT, retreated through the turn, spun five wide for home appearing to be trying to get out some and tired in the stretch.
