Footnotes

EIGHTYFIVE S bobbled slightly at the start, was eased out entering the backstretch, took the lead before going a half, dug in leaving the turn and edged away under steady urging. EXCLUSIVE SCHEME pressed the pace three wide for five furlongs, lodged a bid from outside on the turn but was no match for the winner while holding for the place. CITY VICAR saved ground while outrun to the turn and rallied belatedly. TOGA TIGER raced in close contention three wide into upper stretch and tired. DEEWANEE raced in midpack between rivals and gave way on the turn. MAGGIE'S MIRACLE led briefly along the rail and gave way after going a half. A P GRACIE was never a factor while three wide.
