TOP OF THE SEVENS was well placed in the two path, angled out entering the stretch, took charge a sixteenth out and edged clear late. CAPTAIN NOAH steadied and was shuffled in the early stages, rushed up inside, saved ground to the turn, angled out and finished fastest but could not get up. ROARING SPOUSE dueled early, opened a clear lead in upper stretch and faltered late. BENTBUTNOTBROKEN raced in midpack while three wide for a half and rallied mildly. TONY THE TERIO raced well back along the inside, swung out on the turn and closed some ground late. BRUSHED OFF was outrun after breaking slowly and failed to threaten while saving ground. JET JASON dueled outside to the turn and gave way. GLEN was outrun early, swung five wide and lacked a rally. SMARTY KARAKORUM raced up close along the rail and gave way in upper stretch. NEW PORTWEST raced wide throughout while being outrun.
