FOLLOW BETSY was bumped at the start, argued the pace along the inside, dug in gamely in the stretch and was driving under the wire. MULTIPLE WINS argued the pace while between rivals, gained a short lead in the stretch and was outfinished. LEXILOUSH was outrun early, rallied five wide on the turn and finished well outside. DANCING BLUES was unhurried early, advanced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. MIZ LYNNE KELLY was bumped at the start, chased the pace along the inside and lacked a rally. PAUGUS BAY had no rally. LAST PUFF raced between rivals and had no rally. WINGS OF THE STORM raced wide and tired. CRAFTY WILDCAT chased the pace while three wide and tired. REBELANO was bumped at the start and tired.
