FUTURE PROSPECT opened a long lead on the first turn, was in hand while maintaining a narrow advantage at the half mile pole, dug in when challenged at the quarter pole, battled heads apart leaving the furlong marker and held on gamely to prevail after a long drive. MATTHEW T C raced just behind the winner for a half, closed the gap to challenge at the quarter pole, battled from outside into midstretch but was no match for the top one while narrowly holding for the place. MAGICAL DEVOTION was outrun while in hand for a half, angled three wide leaving the turn then closed gradually but could not get up. GARGANTUA steadied while a bit rank at the half mile pole, angled in on the turn, saved ground into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. SHOT GUN HOLIDAY raced in good position along the rail most of the way, gained on the turn, angled out entering the stretch and lacked a further response. BUY A PERSONALITY broke slowly, was in hand along the rail and failed to mount a serious rally. DANCING ROBBINS was under a firm hold while three wide just off the early pace then gave way midway on the turn.
