KELTIC FIGHTER stumbled at the start, advanced three wide after a half and finished willingly. MUY GUAPO raced evenly between horses. WHITE THUNDER failed to mount a serious rally. AUDIES CHAMP rallied belatedly after breaking slowly. FAIRWAY TOM pressed the winner and gave way on the turn. STASH THE CASH was never close after breaking slowly.
