Footnotes

REDWOOD FEVER contently tracked the pacesetter, resisting an inviting hole along the rail all the while, availed of the opportunity when ready, was let out just past the five-sixteenths pole, accelerated to the front, drew out to a comfortable advantage during the next eighth, then held sway, drifting outward in defiance to the corrective right handed tactics being taken by the rider to try and counteract it. DIXIE NITE OUT put to some light coaxing while traversing in the two path, was asked for more in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, then came home with good energy down the center of the strip to garner place honors. TALK TO NICK coaxed chasing the pacesetter three wide around the turn, held his ground reasonably well to the wire to earn the show. STUDLEY was bumped at the start, left the backstretch four wide, remained in that path for most of the way around the turn, got asked for run near the five-sixteenths pole and was out finished. RUN TO GRAND AVE. was taken in hand after being bumped at the start, raced along the outside, worked his way into a good striking distance upon reaching the quarter pole, but soon flattened out. AUDITORIUM made the lead quickly, showed the way from the two path for a half and gave way. EAST END BOY was hustled early to settle into midpack, cut the corner under a drive but had no rally. GREEN BANANAS saved ground and was no factor. BINDLE STICK was bumped after the start, raced well off the inside and failed to reach contention.
