EX PAT bumped hard with STYLISH FELLA leaving the starting gate, then went on to trade bumps thrice more in rapid succession with the same opponent, got into stride soon afterwards to reach midpack, sat reserved along the outside, well positioned behind the front runners, swung four wide into the stretch, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, closed in more readily thereafter, went on to grab command and edged away. DUCALE broke on top, was placed under a snug hold, had the rider cast a couple of looks to the left while idling alongside the early pacesetter, was released from the near stranglehold leaving the seven-sixteenths pole, vied for command briefly between rivals and than one on one with SMOKIN CONRAD, perched just to the outside in the three path, shook free of the competition during the run through the run through the furlong grounds, failed to stave off the top one, but continued on with good courage to secure the place. PAPA FRITA within striking distance, angled three wide for the stretch run and finished willingly to take the show. SOUND CHASER placed four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, rallied to grab the last major share. SMOKIN CONRAD rushed up three wide, vied for the lead from midpoint on the turn, remained a prominent factor until the eighth pole and gave way. FIVE CASES away well, was the early pacesetter, was put to encouragement in attempt to keep pace nearing the three-eighths pole, wasn't up to the task and faltered. APPLIEDORE displayed brief foot. STYLISH FELLA traded a series of four bumps with the top one at the start, with the first being the most significant, proceeded away from the incident rankly, had the rider come out both irons about midway down the backstretch, failed to regain them, dropped far back, was eased, pulled up and subsequently walked off the track under his own power.
