BOUGHT IN DIXIE, close up outside while in hand, advanced three wide approaching the stretch, quickly drew off and was kept busy to remain well clear to the finish. SQUASHER, away awkwardly and outrun early, rallied four wide and finished gamely from the outside. FIGHTEN BEEZIE, with the pace while between rivals, was steadied on the turn, rallied wide and finished well. REPARATIONS, outrun early, raced wide and lacked a solid finishing punch. PALM BEARER contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. CURLYS GOLD, hustled along on the rail, raced inside and had no response. PANCHO'S FLING contested the pace into the stretch and tired. SUNSHINE AL chased inside and tired. PROSPECTORS BLUES was hustled up to get the lead then stopped after a half mile and was being eased in the stretch.
