### Footnotes

DANEMEI pressed the pace between horses to the top of the stretch, surged to the front in midstretch and edged away underleft hand urging. MARINA MARKET set the pace along the rail into upper stretch, relinquished the lead after the rider had the whip knocked out of his hand in upper stretch and held well to clearly best the others. ARCATA stalked three wide, lodged a mild bid from outside leaving the turn and flattened out. FRENCH TRANSITION failed to mount a serious rally while three wide. EGYPTIAN KING raced just off the pace along the rail and gave way on the turn.
